- The Terms of reference of the Committee will be as under:-2.
 - To Analyze the requests/demands received from various public representatives/organisations, since 2014, for the creation of new (i) zones and divisions on Indian Railways, from the following angles:
 - Operational feasibility
 - Financial implications
 - Administrative issues
 - Staff matters & Industrial Relation (IR) issues
 - Infrastructure availability & other requirements
 - On the basis of above analysis, examine the feasibility of creation of the proposed zones/divisions and accordingly reorganization of existing (ii) zones /divisions.
 - The Committee may consult Zonal Railways in this regard. (iii)
 - The views of Federations/Unions may also be obtained for proposals (iv) which are found to be feasible.
 - The Committee should submit its Interim Report by 28.4.2017 and a detailed Report within a period of three months from the date of constitution of the Committee.
 - The Headquarters of the Committee will be at New Delhi. 4.
 - E&R Branch of Railway Board will be the Nodal Branch for functioning of the Committee. Therefore, all related works/issues including Parl. Questions, RTI cases, their execution and other formalities with regard to the Committee, should be dealt with by E&R Branch.

6. The Convenor and Members of the Committee will draw TA/DA as per extant Rules.
